Steve Binder is a deputy public defender with the San Diego Office of the Primary Public Defender, where he has practiced since 1988. He co-founded the Homeless Court Program (HCP) in 1989 and the Veterans Treatment Review Calendar (VTRC) in 2011. He authored a grant request for Dept. of Justice/Bureau of Justice Assistance funding for the HCP. Mr. Binder has received many awards for his work. He is a Special Advisor and former Chair to the ABA Commission on Homelessness and Poverty, serves on the Judicial Council Collaborative Justice Courts Advisory Committee for the Judicial Council of California and is an Ashoka Fellow.
